Document purpose

This document briefly describes how to interact with SMM Drop-off locator API. Also are described the operations (i.e. methods) that are exposed and response messages

API description

The API offers a single operation that returns a JSON list of drop off locations near the zip code used in the search. The available country list is:

- Germany (DE)
- France (FR)
- Spain (ES)
- Italy (IT)

The arguments list is:

- Country (mandatory)
- PostalCode (mandatory)
- Dropoff type (optional)
- Carrier (optional)
- City (optional)
- Address (optional)

To be able to use the dropoff locator service a valid token is needed.

Every data passed and received with the web-service is based on headers values and JSON strings and everything need to be passed with POST method.

Generate Token

This function allows with valid credentials (http basic authorization) to gain a valid token usable with the other operations.

To be able to use the web service is mandatory to add some headers in the call; in the generate Token the headers are:

- Accept: application/json
- Authorization: Basic (USERNAME:PASSWORD base 64 encoded)
- forcenew: true (default false)

If forcenew is set to true the token will be rigenerated otherwise the service return the active one if exists.

A successful response must return a status field = 0;

The token obtained is valid for 24 hours.

Dropoff locator API

Locator Method:

To be able to use the web service is mandatory to add some headers in the call; these headers are:

- Accept: application/json
- username: testusername
- token: {token}TEST-TOKEN-a0a2-47b0-b1ab-923d2ec4b8ce

If any of the listed mandatory headers is missing an error will be sent and no error label will be generated.

The id field is the information that needs to be used in the "DROPOFF_ID" field when requesting a dropoff label in the SMM web service.

Getinfo Method:

To be able to use the web service is mandatory to add some headers in the call; these headers are:

- Accept: application/json
- username: testusername
- token: {token}TEST-TOKEN-a0a2-47b0-b1ab-923d2ec4b8ce

If any of the listed mandatory headers is missing an error will be sent and no error label will be generated.

This method allow the user to get all the informations regarding a single Dropoff Point; the method expects ad a mandatory argument the dropoffid (string type)
